From time to time, we, in the Color Corps, are asked what the meaning is of the different colors worn by the Color Corps. The colors signify the rank, or position, of the bearer. Below find a breakdown of the different colors:

Blue Cape and Chapeau – Vice Supreme Master and Former Vice Supreme Masters

Gold Cape and Chapeau – Masters and Former District Masters

Green Cape and Chapeau – District Marshals

White Cape and Chapeau – Faithful Navigators and Past Faithful Navigators

Purple Cape and Chapeau – Assembly Commanders

Red Cape and White Chapeau – Color Corps
