CHANGES in the MASS

The implementation to the changes in the Mass begins on the 1st Sunday of Advent 27 November, the beginning of the Church's year. The changes in the Mass are more than theological quibbling. The changes in the English translation of the Roman Missal are meant to bring clarity and to express better what the apostles, saints and Church Fathers prayed in the past and to be more align with the scriptures. The new translation parallels other languages like Spanish. Since Blessed John Paul II canonized many saints, the Roman Missal includes prayers for their observances, additional Votive Masses as well as Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions.
