RESOLUTION TO WEAR THE NATIONAL FLAG/FOURTH  
LAPEL PIN  
BY COLOR CORPS SIR KNIGHTS AT ALL TIMES

At the June dinner meeting, the Assembly will consider and vote upon the following amendment. It is to clarify when to where certain pins with certain regalia. The Central District wants all Assemblies (including ours) to vote on it.

WHEREAS, The Supreme Master has instructed all members to wear the official pin of the Fourth Degree (item PG-113) when in official regalia dress, and

WHEREAS, The Supreme Master has authorized the Color Corps members to wear the National Flag Pin of their respective countries while in Color Corps Regalia, and

WHEREAS, The Supreme Master has instructed that no member wear separate Flag and Fourth Degree (item PG-113) Pins while in Color Corps Regalia, and

WHEREAS, Color Corps members at certain functions need to remove their Color Corps Regalia after the formal ceremonies are complete, and

WHEREAS, the members must then remove the National Flag Pin and replace it with the Fourth Degree Pin (item PG-113), and

WHEREAS, there is no current incentive for members to join the Color Corps,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

the Supreme Master grant the Color Corps members be allowed to wear the National Flag Pin while in Regalia or while in Color Corps Regalia, and that this act as an incentive for other members to become an active member of the Color Corps.
