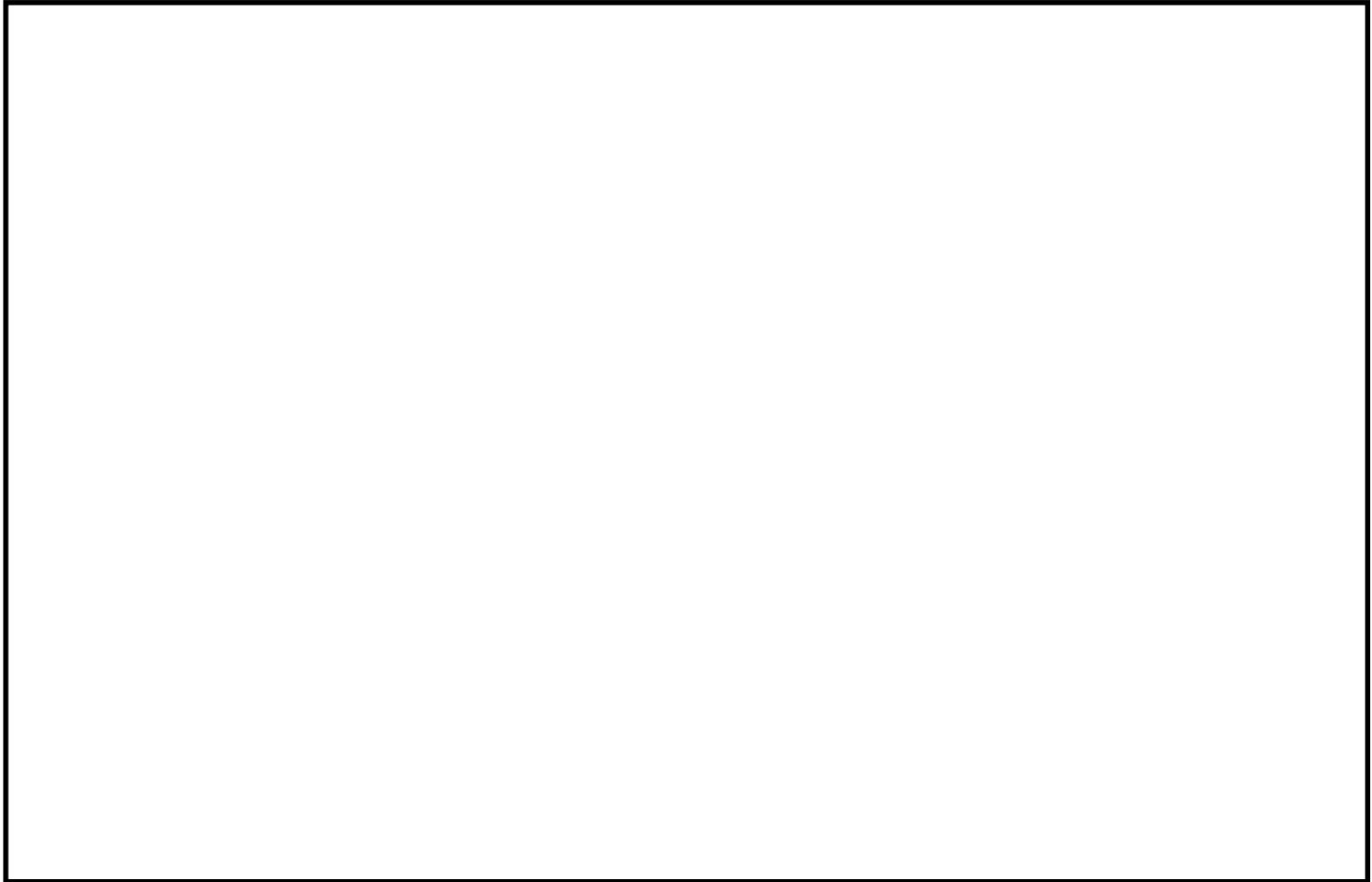

EASTER SUNDAY REFLECTION

"We have seen the Lord."

In the Gospel of John, Mary Magdalene is the first person to meet the risen Jesus. She becomes the first missionary when she is sent to the apostles to bring them the news that Jesus is alive. They will look for the risen Jesus (John 20:1-18). In spite of what Peter saw at the empty tomb and the faith of the beloved disciple, the apostles are still blocked as a community. They keep the doors closed for fear of the "Jews", they are even more closed in on themselves. Only their common experience of the risen Lord will open them enough to share the Good News with others. The decisive moment comes on the Sunday evening. The greeting of Jesus "*Peace be with you*" gives them the peace they so much need. The peace, they receive from Jesus empowers them for their mission just as Jesus had promised. For the disciples, the Scriptures will continue to have an important role. To remember what God said to them through Jesus and to interpret His words together as a community opens up the door of their hearts and lets Jesus in. They realize that the promises He made before His death are fulfilled. People inside and outside the Church are waking up to the importance of the Scriptures for their lives. When we pray and share the Scriptures, we can, like the Apostles exclaim, "*We have seen the Lord.*" This joyful discovery, however, is not just meant for ourselves, but especially for those still outside who are searching for real meaning to their lives, the risen Lord.
