THE CHALICE IN MEMORY OF GEORGE BOURGEOIS GOES TO KOYUKUK, AK

In gratitude and celebration of George's years of knightly service and life as a Catholic gentleman, the Junipero Assembly of fourth degree Knights of Columbus commissioned a chalice and paten, which was sent to the Diocese of Fairbanks, Alaska. It will be used on the frontier of the faith in a remote northern village of Koyukuk. This village is in a very remote spot at the confluence of the Yukon and Koyukuk rivers 290 air miles west of Fairbanks, reached by light plane or boat. It is inhabited with about 80 Athabaskan natives. Residents live a subsistence lifestyle hunting for moose and waterfowl, fishing for salmon and whitefish, and berry picking. Trapping and beadwork supplement incomes. Missionary priests from the Oblates of Mary Immaculate and the Society of Jesus celebrated the first baptisms in the late 1800's. Koyukuk has never had a resident priest but a church dedicated to St. Patrick was constructed during the years 1958-1962. It was replaced in 1988 when the town's old generator building was converted into the new Saint Patrick's church. The parish is served by parish administrators and other trained lay staff members whose ministry is supported by priests and religious brothers or sisters from larger village centers. Celebrations of the Word with Holy Communion replace Sunday Mass when a priest is unavailable
