

# Rev. Lawrence Santos Appointed Administrator Pro-Tem of Our Lady Queen of Angels Parish in Lompoc

Rev. Joy Lawrence L. Santos, Associate Pastor at St. Raphael's Church since July 1, 2010, has been appointed Administrator Pro-Tem of Our Lady Queen of Angels Parish in Lompoc effective July 1.


Father Santos became a member of the Knights of Columbus in 2008 when he was assigned as Associate Pastor of Our Lady of the Valley Church in Canoga Park. Currently he serves as Chaplain for Goleta Valley Council 5300.

Father Santos will be taking the place of Rev. Msgr. John G. Fitzgerald who was the first Associate Pastor at St. Raphael under Pastor Edward J. Hempfling from 1962-67. Msgr. Fitzgerald, native of Ireland, was ordained a priest on June 3, 1962 so will be celebrating his Golden Jubilee soon. He was invested as a Monsignor in 1994. Msgr. Fitzgerald came to Our Lady Queen of Angels Parish in 1972, a remarkable and incredible 40-year service to his parishioners. He will remain in retirement at the parish.

This new assignment for Fr. Santos will be his tenth since his ordination on October 26, 1991. A native of Solano, Nueva Vizcaya, Philippines, Father came to the United States in June 2006. In his near 21-years as a priest, Fr. Santos stated, "Even though I was here at St, Raphael for only two years, just being here is something great." 


# Happy 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday on June 22 **Kenneth Edward Riley**





## 2012 Fish Frys A Success Due to Dedicated Volunteers by Rich Scholl


(A note from the Editor: This IMPORTANT article was submitted for the last month's Knightline, but was accidentally omitted. All apologies for this oversight!)

# Knights of Columbus, Goleta Valley Council 5300 to Celebrate 50th Anniversary on Saturday, June 16

Celebrating their 50th Anniversary the Knights of Columbus Council 5300 is planning a special dinner and program on Saturday, June 16 at 6:30 p.m. in the St. Raphael Parish Hall.

Spearheading this special milestone event are PGK Paul Coyne (1986-87) and PGK Bill McNamara (1990-91) who cordially invite all members and their guests to an extra-delicious meal (rib-eye steak, assorted appetizers, garden salad, baked potato, green beans/almonds, strawberry shortcake and red and white wine on the tables. The program will feature a slide show spotlighting some of the many projects and programs since May 14, 1962 - charter date.

McNamara with assistance from PGK Francisco Cabrera (2007-08) is preparing this interesting historical recollection.

Tickets are \$15 and may be purchased at the Parish Rectory, from PGK Brian Klinge, ticket sales chairman and Coyne or Grand Knight Ed Barrier.

The history of the Council 5300 goes back to 1961 when Walter Daniel Merrigan, Jr., began to recruit members. When the required number became members the Council was chartered - May 14, 1962. Merrigan served two years as Grand Knight. Merrigan became a Knight at age 18 in Las Vegas before moving to Santa Barbara and becoming the Grand Knight at age 31 of St. Raphael Council 5300. In the early 1970's the name was changed to Goleta Valley Council 5300 to indicate support for any other parishes in the area, but most members are still deeply involved in the St. Raphael Church parish and community.

Of the original 39 Charter Members, only five are members today. These five are Paul Christiansen, Paul Curzan, Francis Diani, Thomas Puerling and Bruce Velasco. Noted on the Charter Plaque are James Anderson, Charles H. Burke, Paul E. Christiansen, Jesus A. Contreras, G. A. Corbett, Paul C. Curzan, Francis A. Diani, Richard H. Donlon, William E. Merrigan, Jr., Peter J. Moglia, Edward J. O'Meara, William O'Neill, Ted Ontiveros, Donald H. Parkinson, Vincent D. Poirier, Thomas E. Puerling, J. H. Quigley, Robert P. Richards, A. W. Roe, Valdez A. Almost all of the priests assigned to St. Raphael's have been Knights beginning with Pastor Edward J. Hempfling, the Charter Chaplain, to Pastor, Rev. Msgr. Stephen Noel Downes. Four of the five Deacons at St. Raphaels have been or are members.

Members have served as Eucharistic Ministers, Ministers to the Sick, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Lectors, Cantors, Ushers, Parish Council members, Choir members, CCD instructors, Rosary makers, money counters and groundskeepers. They also serve the parish school through the PTC, School Board Fund-raisers, Essay contest, Adopt-a-Student Program and in times past, built playground equipment, school lunch tables and benches and performed maintenance, painting and landscaping.

Knights were instrumental in starting the Bike-a-thon for Diabetes, the annual Spaghetti Dinner Fund-raiser for Jodi House, support of the Villa Majella Pregnancy Counseling Center, Transition House, Keep Christ in Christmas cards, Council of Christmas Cheer, Christmas Unity, Catholic Charities, St. Vincent School, Special Olympics and staff a Poll Election Station. The Knights are also known for their support of youth programs such as Cub Scouts, Boy and Girl Scouts, Parish Youth Groups, basketball free throw contest, Children's Mentally Challenged (Tootsie Roll) Fund Raising Drive, and the St. Mark's Student Retreats. In recent years they completed Council's pledge to donate \$100,000 to St. Raphael's to build the Community Center, sponsor the annual Bill McLafferty Golf Tournament for charity, give aid to the poor through St. Vincent De Paul Society, provide parishes with annual calendars, support Old Spanish Days at the Mercado in DelaGuerra Plaza with the KC Fiesta Coke Booth, the Color Corps marches in the Fiesta Parade, sponsor blood donation, (Continued on page 12)

A special distinction as the Best Community Project in the Country occurred in 1977 from Supreme Council for Council's leadership in conducting all Track and Field events at Special Olympics on the UCSB campus. This event took place for several years.


